If you would like to be added to the birthday list, please leave a note on door #510 with your Unit Number, Name and your Birthday (year is not mandatory). This list includes anniversary dates. When there is a change to the list, it will be updated and left at your door. Cards & gifts are not requested or required. It's up to each individual. You can just wish your neighbors "Happy Birthday". If you have already signed up, you can ignore this message.

## To report a phone scam to the government, you can:

- Tell the FTC at [ReportFraud.ftc.gov](http://ReportFraud.ftc.gov) if you've lost money to a phone scam or have information about the company or scammer who called you.
- Use the streamlined reporting form at [DoNotCall.gov](http://DoNotCall.gov) if you didn't lose money and just want to report a call.
- Report the incident through the [FBI's Internet Crime Complaint Center](http://FBI's Internet Crime Complaint Center) if you believe you are a victim of fraud.
- Report online, business, or phone scams to the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) at [ReportFraud.ftc.gov](http://ReportFraud.ftc.gov).
- Tell the FTC at [ReportFraud.ftc.gov](http://ReportFraud.ftc.gov) if you spot a government imposter.
